Who Is Credit Valley Conservation?

Credit Valley Conservation (CVC) is one of 36 conservation authorities in Ontario dedicated to conserving, restoring, and managing our local environment. Conservation authorities were formed by Act of the government of Ontario in 1946 and as a result CVC has been working locally for over 50 years on environmental issues in the watershed. We are a community-based environmental organization working in partnership with our municipalities. This partnership provides the opportunity for citizens (just like you) to become involved in activities that promote better environmental health in the places where we live, work, play and go to school. Over time our volunteers have planted many thousands of trees along the Credit River watershed and much, much more. This volunteer program provides youth with chances to do the same and many other fun and interesting things that all benefit our local environment.

What Is The Conservation Youth Corps Program?

Conservation Youth Corps (CYC) is a program of CVC that enriches the lives of youth through volunteerism, fun and learning about conservation and the environment. This is a week-long program that runs for all 9 weeks of summer. Volunteers participate with CVC staff in a variety of important stewardship activities. Examples include planting trees, aquatic and terrestrial monitoring programs, the construction of fish and wildlife habitat, maintaining our vast trail network and managing invasive species throughout the watershed.

Volunteers can receive up to 35 community involvement hours. While doing so volunteers have the opportunity to learn about the environment, explore different areas of their watershed, and meet new people. The time spent and skills learned while volunteering can provide many additional benefits for any teen who, for example may be looking for skills and experience to put on a job or a university application. CVC is committed to providing high quality, fun and interesting programming for our participants. Our goal is for this experience to be both environmentally and socially relevant for everyone.

Program Eligibility:

In order to be eligible to participate applicants must be at least 14 years of age, have completed grade 9 and planning to return to high school in the following September.

Application Process:

If you are submitting a paper, hard copy form you must send the last three (3) pages (pages 5, 6, 7) of this application to Credit Valley Conservation to be considered for participation. Please send it by mail, fax, courier or personal delivery to the address given on the last page of this document. You may also apply directly online at www.creditvalleyca.ca/cyc. If you are applying online, a hard copy of page five (5) of this package (will pop-up after clicking "Send") complete with the signature of a parent or guardian must be sent and received at CVC

within **one week** of online submission in order to complete the application process. Incomplete information, missing signatures, or amendments to any part of this form will result in your application not being considered. REFER TO THE APPLICATION CHECK LIST ON THE LAST PAGE BEFORE SENDING.

Notice of Program Acceptance:

Apply early! Applications are considered on a first come, first served basis and also on our ability to form work-crews at various locations throughout the watershed. A notice will be posted on the website once the program is full and registration is closed. Applicants will be notified by email of their placement status by June 11, 2010. Applications not initially awarded placement will be added to the waitlist.

Pick Up & Drop Off Times & Locations:

Students' pick up and drop off times may vary however a CYC volunteer can expect to meet at approximately 9am each morning and dropped off at approximately 4pm each afternoon at a the designated spot. We will provide as much notice as possible of any changes in that schedule. Traditionally, local high schools are used as meeting spots. When filling out your application please indicate to us **all** high schools that are easily accessible to you. The more we know the more likely it is we can accommodate you.

Accessibility:

CVC is committed to being accessible to all eligible (by age) youth in the watershed. Participants who require additional assistance or have special needs are asked (or their parents are asked) to indicate those needs to us in this form. If this pertains to you or your child we also ask to be contacted immediately following your application in order to discuss the nature and extent of accommodations necessary to ensure a positive experience with CYC for your child. For reasons relating to the health and safety of staff and participants, participation in certain activities may be restricted or acceptance into the program denied if suitable accommodations for special needs cannot be safely made.

Privacy and Use of Information Policy:

Credit Valley Conservation (CVC) respects the rights of individuals to the privacy of their personal information and is subject to the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (MFIPPA). The information collected herein will not used for commercial purposes of any kind. Personal information will be used for internal administrative purposes, in the event of emergency, to contact participants as part of a post-program evaluation and/or may also be used to inform participants as to the availability of new programs or events. All information is kept confidential and will only be used or disclosed in accordance with MFIPPA rules and regulations.

Terms & Conditions and Volunteer Release Statement

Terms and Conditions

1. The CYC Summer Program is a week long volunteer program of Credit Valley Conservation for high school aged youth living or going to school in the Credit River watershed area.
2. CYC agrees to provide evidence of a student's volunteer participation for their community involvement hours requirement for high school graduation or for any other request for verification of volunteer hours upon the completion of their time with us (i.e.: we sign your form at the end of the week).
3. Credit Valley Conservation will not pay a salary or hourly wage to CYC participants.
4. CYC week long programs offer up to 35 hours volunteer time to high school students. Credit for additional hours can be obtained from CVC by participating in other CVC run volunteer events.
5. CYC will provide transportation to and from the assigned meeting place and all CYC work or activity sites only.
6. Transportation to and from the designated meeting place each morning will be the participants' responsibility.
7. Volunteer contributions accumulate each day once a participant is picked up by the CYC Crew Leader in the morning at the assigned meeting place and stop once returned to the meeting place at the end of the day.
8. Only actual volunteered time will be reflected in our records and on any document CVC provides as evidence of volunteered time. For civic holidays, cancellation of a day's activities, or for any reason a participant has missed a day, volunteer hours will not be calculated.
9. Each day volunteers will be given a break for lunch and routine breaks in both the morning and afternoon.
10. Participants will be supervised by CYC Crew Leaders and CVC staff.
11. Participants shall return any equipment or supplies provided to them unless otherwise stated.
12. Participants for the week are expected to be present on the first day of each new week for health and safety orientation, code of conduct information and other relevant training or preparation.
13. Continued participation in CYC is dependant upon adherence to all rules, safety guidelines and any instructions as given by CVC staff including CYC's Code of Conduct as found on our website www.creditvalleyca.ca/cyc.
14. In the event that a health and safety policy or safety standard is being or is about to be violated, or if a person is in any jeopardy, immediate action will be taken by **the site supervisor in charge** to restore and/or maintain safety at all times. This may result in some of the following actions but not limited to: the cancellation of or alteration to a CYC activity, the removal of any number of individuals from the activity or the program, or refusal to permit an individual(s) from participating in an activity on the grounds that it may constitute a safety policy violation or failure to meet a safety standard.
15. Participants must report all injuries, no matter how slight, to their supervisor.
16. CVC reserves the right to terminate this program or the placement status of any participant at any time for failure to comply with these terms and conditions.

VOLUNTEER RELEASE, WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY, MEDICAL TREATMENT AUTHORIZATION AND PHOTOGRAPHIC RELEASE AGREEMENT

Please read carefully! By signing this document you will have agreed to waive certain legal rights, including the right to sue.

I/we, on my/our own behalf and on behalf of my/our heirs, executors, estate trustees with or without a Will, administrators, next of kin, successors and assigns:

Assumption of Risk

- agree, acknowledge and understand that participation in CYC will include but is not limited to the following activities: those which take place out-of-doors, possibly during inclement weather (poor, cold, rainy, etc.) and entail physical labour (i.e.: tree planting or other), the use of hand tools (shovels, hammers and/or other non-power tools), walking over rough or slippery terrain and being transported in CVC's vehicles ("the Activities");
- agree, acknowledge and understand that while the health and safety of the Participant and staff is always the first priority for the CVC, such Activities are not totally without risk;
- agree to assume the risk for any loss, damage, or destruction of personal property AND / OR injury, harm or death to the Registrant in the Activities however caused INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASED PARTIES ("the CVC"), HOWSOEVER CAUSED.

Release, Waiver of Liability and Indemnity

- agree to release the CVC from all liability, whether direct or indirect, and waive all claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses, actions or causes of actions arising out of or in consequence of any death, injury, loss or damage to my person or property or that of my child or ward, however caused, while attending at or participating in the Activities; including but not limited to, breach of the Occupier's Liability Act;
- agree to further waive and release the CVC from any recourse which I or my child or ward may now or hereafter have resulting from any decision of the CVC;
- agree to indemnify the CVC from and assume full responsibility for any claims demands, damages, costs, expenses, actions or causes of actions it may incur arising out of or in consequence of any death, injury, loss or damage due to my participation or that of my child's or ward's attendance or participation in the Activities;

Medical Treatment

- consent for the Participant in the event of injury or illness while under the supervision of the CVC to receive first aid and/or any further medical attention that potentially may be required to the extent determined by, and at the discretion of CVC staff, emergency medical services, and licensed medical professionals;

Photographic Release

- agree to grant permission for images of the Participant captured during regular CYC Activities through video, photo and digital camera, to be used solely for the purposes of the CVC's promotional material and publications including appearance in local news media coverage of CYC Activities and do hereby waive any rights of compensation or ownership;

Other

- agree that this Release shall be governed by the laws of Ontario;
- agree that if any portion of this Release is held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such clause or provision shall not otherwise affect the remaining provisions of this Release which shall continue in full legal force and effect; and
- agree that no oral representations have been made.
